Bus pick up time is TBD on all trips, you will be notified in advance by HRHS. So all times quoted here are approximate. You will pay the bus driver directly as you board the bus. Exact change is required. Bus fare is in addition to the Admission Fees. Bus Passes not accepted for Senior Ride. Tipping is acceptable.

Rides are \$2.60 round-trip for seniors 65 or older, or \$5.20 if less than 65 Yr.

(Some Regional Fares slightly higher at \$4.50 to \$5.20 round-trip)
